1. Commissioner Domec made the motion to accept the Commissioner Meeting minutes from the March 16, 2021 and submit the financial report of March 2021 for audit. Commissioner Biehslich seconded the motion. Motion carried
2. Citizens Comments: Robert McCurley requested some of our firefighters take a trip over to Alabama To check on a fire apparatus for sale. Commissioner Nash made a motion to send a few employees to Alabama to check out the engine for sale. Commissioner Biehslich seconded the motion. Motion carried
3. Commissioner Biehslich made a motion to approve the Homestead exemption to be the same as the previous year which was no percentage deduction, but a deduction of \$10,000 for either disabled or over 65 years of age. Commissioner Domec seconded the motion. Motion Carried
3. Allegiance representative Monty Cartwright reported an overall percentage of 95 % compliance. Said the wall time was improving.

Commissioner's correspondence, President Boyett reported on the numerous problems we've had with the apparatus which were supposed to have been serviced by Sieben's which are being found to not have been performed. Still water in rear axle of R1. Oil and transmission fluid failed testing. transmission plug showed to be original from 2016 which had never been removed. Spoke with attorney on these issues.  
Commissioner Nash suggested we get with VISD pd and do training on the different schools and The locations at the schools of certain facilities and rooms in regards to safety if some disaster arose.
